[The Science Works Visits Kindergarten and More Science Enrichment Programming](#)

Every year, HOP funds (through parent contributions) approximately 20 different programs that are meant to supplement and support the science curriculum for each grade.

Our first program of the 2015-16 school year kicked off last week. Stephen Lechner from [The Science Works](#) came to the kindergarten classes on Tuesday, Oct. 27th. Steve dazzled the children with the amazing properties of water. Ask your child to show you how a glass of water turned into a "gigantifier". How can it make a penny disappear? Did you know that on a sunny day, you can make a

rainbow on your ceiling with just a glass of water? How can a paperclip both sink and float? It was wonderful to see the kindergartners enthusiastically making predictions and observations, presenting their ideas on how certain "tricks" worked, and testing their guesses. Who knew science could be so fun?

On Nov. 4th, the 2nd and 5th graders will see a show on the principles involved in creating different weather patterns. Thanks again to all of you who generously donate to HOP!
