## Weather Shows for the 2nd and 5th Grades

On Nov. 4th, Tom Wahle from [Techsploration](#) came to give a presentation on the science of weather to the 2nd and 5th grade students. First, he demonstrated that air takes up space, has weight and that it moves from high pressure to low pressure. Ask your student how he did these experiments! He talked about weather fronts, hurricanes, and tornadoes. Using a Van de Graff generator, Mr. Wahle demonstrated the concepts of electricity and illustrated how lightning bolts are formed.

In a few weeks, Mr. Wahle will be back at Haynes to talk to the 4th graders about electricity. The students will be experimenting with circuits, insulators and conductors.

## 5th Grade Safety Patrol Update

Safety Patrol began on Nov. 2nd. We are using the month of November as a "trial and error" month, as students are just becoming familiar with their job responsibilities and expectations. The most challenging aspect of Safety Patrol is the need to self-advocate. Although students have specific job responsibilities, many tasks require finding a time that accommodates both their schedule and another classroom's schedule. By December, the hope is that students have initiated conversations with teachers about how best to accomplish this. Congratulations to our current Safety Patrol members!
