School Meeting

An important part of the Haynes School tradition is our Whole School Meeting.

We have Monday Morning Meetings, which are hosted by Fifth Grade students, at 9:00 a.m. on Mondays. The format includes the pledge of allegiance, a patriotic song and a recognition of the week's birthdays, both students and staff. There is a Character message for the week which the fifth graders read to the school. These include stories and messages about character traits and the children are encouraged "with something to think about...make it a great day...or not. The choice is yours!"
