[NEW Traffic Pattern Update](#)

- The NEW traffic pattern is going very smoothly. We drive on the RIGHT now! Thank you for your patience and flexibility.
- Reminder that we can have two lanes of cars in the Access Lane which funnel to one lane as a MERGE to the Drop-Off and Pick-Up line. Stop at the Stop signs before merging.
- Please remember to enter the Access Lane with caution. You can enter from either direction on Haynes Road now - don't speed into the lane and watch for buses.
- Please remember RIGHT TURN only between 8:30-9:00 and 3:15-3:45 when exiting the Drop-Off and Pick-Up line.
- Do not get out of the car during Drop-Off and Pick-Up. Your children should be ready to exit the car on the passenger side

[BOKS \(Build Our Kids' Success\) Before School Exercise Program](#)

BOKS, a before-school physical activity program for kids, will continue at Haynes this fall! BOKS prepares children for a day of learning and is an important step in helping children gain an appreciation of the benefits of exercise and healthy choices that will last a lifetime.

Typical BOKS Class:

- 40 minutes long
- Fun warm-up game or movement drills
- Running activity, relay races, obstacle courses and strength movements
- Fun game
- Cool down and a BOKS Bit- a nutrition component of the program

BOKS will run 2 mornings per week OUTSIDE on the back playground from 8-8:45 a.m. The fall session starts week of Sept. 19 and runs thru the week of Oct 24th. Registration forms will be available soon. Parents will be responsible for transporting their children to school. Children who attend SED are eligible to enroll and participate. Please note, that sessions may be cancelled due to inclement weather. We will try our best to give as much notice of cancellation as possible. This will be done via email.
