

HOP General Meeting Minutes

Monday, June 6, 2016

Board Members in Attendance: Molly Logan, Mandy Sim, Patty Vadgama, Rory Richards, Kelly Pacific Molly Logan and Mandy Sim.

Co-Chairs: Welcome with a big thank you to all volunteers for a successful year! Mandy introduced the new board members of Dayna Buckley, co-chair, Alison Riquier, fundraising co-chair, and Jenn Stone, assistant treasurer.
