## Fall BOKS

**Register by Friday September 15th! Starts on Tuesday September 19th!!!**

BOKS (Build Our Kids' Success) is a volunteer-run, fun, before-school physical activity program for kids. Each session lasts 6 weeks and meets 2 days per week for 45 minutes. Some of the activities include running, jumping, hopping, hula hooping, learning new skills and so much more!

BOKS will run every Tuesday and Thursday morning OUTSIDE on the back playground from 8:00 - 8:45 a.m. The 6 week fall session starts on Tuesday, September 19th and ends on Thursday, October 26th. Complete one [Registration Form](#) for each child and submit with a check for \$25 (per child) made out to Haynes Organization of Parents (HOP) by Friday, September 15th. Scholarships are available. Forms can be returned directly to the BOKS mailbox at the front desk. Approximately 40 children may participate in the session, and the participants will be chosen via lottery (if necessary). Parents will be responsible for transporting their children to school. Children who attend SED are eligible to enroll and participate. Please note, that sessions may be cancelled or moved inside due to inclement weather. We will try our best to give as much notice of cancellation as possible. This will be done via email.

We hope that you will share our enthusiasm for this program and you will, in turn, see a positive impact on your children. Please contact us with any questions, or you can check out the BOKS website ([www.bokskids.org](http://www.bokskids.org)). We are asking each family to volunteer to help out with the program one morning per session - either on a Tuesday or Thursday. A Sign Up Genius will be sent out to all families enrolled. ## Haynes Print Directory and AtoZ App Directory Information for 2017-2018

The ONLINE version of the Haynes School Directory will be shut down on September 1st in order to update for this 2017-2018 school year. Please remember to go to [haynespto.org](http://haynespto.org) and click on the [School Directory Link](#) to make sure everything is up to date for your child. Please remember that only YOU have control of whether you are in or out of the Directory. The Directory Coordinator's role is solely to input the family information into the Directory database, which is accessible only to faculty and parents who buy the Directory Package. This being said, whatever choice you make after the deadline for the print directory being printed can not be changed in the "print" directory, BUT you can opt-in or out of any part of the online Directory at any time! Did you maybe opt-out of your child being listed in the class directory, but now want them in? Do you have a new cell phone number? Do you want to include another email address? Just log-in and change your preference and/or contact information. The online directory makes it all so easy!

The cutoff to get us your information to be included in the printed version will be the end of September, so please stay tuned for the final date to verify your information.
