It's time for CHESS! Join Josiah Haynes' popular Chess club taught by Chess Master Dmitry Frenklakh. Any level and age are welcome!

Our Chess club provides children with a solid foundation on which to build and grow their skills of visualization and deductive reasoning. We have all ages from kindergarten to 5th grade. A child who is introduced to chess at a young age is likely to do better in school for years to come. Research shows that playing chess improves a child's thinking, problem-solving, reading, and math scores. Educators and chess experts generally agree the first grade is the ideal time to introduce children to chess, although some as young as four or five may be ready to learn and play. It really helps children in building self-confidence. We hope to have your child join us!

Stop & Shop's A+ School Rewards Program

A+ School Rewards are points that supporters earn with each purchase made using their Stop & Shop Card. At the end of each month, the points are converted to a cash total, which is then automatically credited to our school's account. To register your Stop & Shop card for the program, visit <https://stopandshop.com/school-rewards>. Our school code is 08425. So far, only 111 families have registered for this easy money-making activity so if you haven't already done so, be sure to sign up soon! The rewards program runs from September through mid-March and you do not need to re-register every year.
